
In 1838 Catherine Greve came from Hanover, Germany to Illinois with the Greve, Ottman, Meyer and Schirding families. She and Johann Sunderlage were married here and lived in a dugout and later a log blockhouse. In 1856 Sunderlage hired carpenter Hiram Thurston to build his house.

The house is available to rent for small parties of less than 49 people. Three rooms on the main level can be used. There are two restrooms. The kitchen has a large refrigerator and stove that can be used to warm food. Tables and chairs are available.
