Mrs. Musiala stated that during the month of December 2018, for Operating funds cash disbursements and transfers-out exceeded cash receipts and transfers-in by \$1.61 million, primarily due to general operating expenses. After including these receipts and disbursements, the balance of cash and investments for the operating funds is \$41.4 million.

For the Operating, Debt Service and Capital Projects funds, cash disbursements and transfers-out exceeded cash receipts and transfers-in by \$1.63 million, primarily due to general operating expenses.

For the Trust Funds, cash receipts and transfers-in exceeded cash disbursements and transfers-out by \$951,351, primarily due to investment activity in pension funds.

The total for cash and investments for all funds increased to \$227.7 million.

Mr. Belmonte stated it will make the school easier to find and is a point of pride for their students to see their school name on the wall. Commissioners asked Mr. Belmonte to describe the sign. Staff directed the Commission to the attached sign drawing submittal to provide a visual of the sign Winston Knolls School would like to install.

Staff explained to the Commission that the reason for the request is that the original Master Sign Plan approved in 2008 did not include allowance for wall signs. Staff stated they would contact the Owner and have a revised General Application submitted stating that Mr. Michael Belmonte as an authorized owner's representative.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8-3-22, NUMBER OF LICENSES
OF ARTICLE 3, ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS, OF THE
HOFFMAN ESTATES MUNICIPAL CODE (INCREASE IN
NUMBER OF CLASS "A" LICENSES, ELSA RESTAURANT GROUP
HOFFMAN ESTATES LLC D/B/A ELSA'S, 711 W. GOLF ROAD)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hoffman Estates, Cook and Kane Counties, Illinois, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: That Section 8-3-22, <u>NUMBER OF LICENSES</u>, of the Hoffman Estates Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

The number of licenses issued to persons for the sale of alcoholic liquors by the Village of Hoffman Estates shall be limited to sixty-two (62) Class "A" licenses, two (2) Class "AA" licenses, fifteen (15) Class "B" licenses, unlimited Class "C" licenses, four (4) Class "D" licenses, two (2) Class "DD" licenses, one (1) Class "F" license, one (1) Class "G" licenses, unlimited Class "H" licenses, one (1) Class "I" license, eighteen (18) Class "LC" licenses, one (1) Class "AC" license and eight (8) Class "J" licenses.

<u>Section 2</u>: That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 3: That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to publish this ordinance in pamphlet form.
