Proceed with the five-year capital improvement plan with an emphasis on the sanitary sewer rehabilitation program and the roadway rehabilitation program, including reconstruction, resurfacing and preventative maintenance.



Coordinate a comprehensive economic development program to promote business retention, redevelopment of the Business District and attraction of new business investment and creation of new marketing strategies to promote Hoffman Estates.



Enhance neighborhood residential revitalization efforts that encourage reinvestment in aging areas through promotion of property maintenance.



Continue involvement in regional transportation studies by supporting the proposed EJ&E transit line and full interchange at Barrington Road & I-90. Explore public transportation options to improve efficiency and local traffic flow.



Evaluate public-private partnership opportunities to establish relationships with the private sector in order to benefit commercial, residential and technological ventures.



Continue innovations in service delivery through improvements in technology such as e-commerce programs, on-line payments and an automatic citizen notification system.



Maintain effective public safety programs to ensure the health, safety and welfare of residents and businesses.



Develop programs and opportunities which encourage all cultural and ethnic populations within the Village to become engaged in the community.



Provide financially responsible management and use of public funds through fiscally conservative governance.



Continue to advocate a realignment of zip codes with the U.S. Postal Service to provide codes that are unique to Hoffman Estates with the least disruption to residents and businesses.
