1. Request authorization for a waiver of formal bid (due to sole source) and to award a five year contract for the replacement of certain video cameras in the Police Department to Axon Enterprise Inc., Scottsdale, AZ in an amount not to exceed \$537,320.08.

An item summary sheet from Chief Kasia Cawley was presented to Committee.

Chief Cawley addressed the Committee and reported that the Police Department currently utilizes the same closed circuit video camera system that is used within the entire Village Hall. The State mandates that certain interviews being conducted by the Police Department be recorded on video and the Third Circuit Court also requires all processing and lockup footage on arrests be retained. Axon offers a building camera solution that can automatically extract the videos in the Police Department and move the required video to Evidence.com where the officer's BWC and in-car camera video resides.

Payment of the system will be amortized over five years and the cameras and equipment are covered by a total warranty for five years.

Motion by Trustee Kinnane, seconded by Trustee Arnet, for a waiver of formal bid (due to sole source) and to award a five year contract for the replacement of certain video cameras in the Police Department to Axon Enterprise Inc., Scottsdale, AZ in an amount not to exceed \$537,320.08.
