BACKGROUND:

In June 2024, the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC) Governing Board approved a one-year period with Al Warren Fuel Company with the right to extend the contract for three additional one-year periods under the same terms and conditions. A letter with details concerning the 2024 contract is attached to this memorandum.

DISCUSSION:

The Village has purchased fuel through SPC contract for over twenty years with satisfactory results. The SPC contract provides the Village with diesel and unleaded fuel at a competitive price by pooling the fuel demands of many municipalities and other agencies to realize economies of scale. Staff is recommending continuing participation in this cooperative.

The Village purchases approximately 130,000 to 140,000 gallons of unleaded and 50,000 to 60,000 gallons of diesel fuel per year. The average cost per gallon to-date in 2024 has been \$2.93 for unleaded and \$3.17 for diesel.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

There is \$670,000 in the 2024 General Fund operating budget for diesel and unleaded fuel purchases. To date, the Village has spent \$270,000 on fuel through the expiring SPC contract.

RECOMMENDATION:

Request authorization to:

- a. Participate in the Northwest Municipal Conference Suburban Purchasing Cooperative for a one-year contract with Al Warren Fuel Company, Hammond, IN, for joint purchase of diesel and unleaded fuel; and
- b. Authorization to participate annually for three additional one-year periods under the same terms and conditions.

This letter is to inform you that the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC) Governing Board has approved the award of the 2024 Gasoline (87, 89, & 92 Octane), Diesel Fuel, Ethanol 75 & 85 and B20 Bio Diesel Fuel Contract (#230) to Al Warren Oil Co., Inc. based on your responsible, responsive bid in compliance with all bid specification requirements.

BACKGROUND:

Pfizer Lift Station, constructed in 1975 at 2090 Central Road, is a dry well-wet well prefabricated steel duplex-style underground pumping station. This station discharges sewage through a force main that runs south under the tollway and connects to a gravity sewer. The station's service area was originally zoned for light industrial use; however, in recent years, changes in the service area include Bell Works, the Microsoft Data Center, and commercial, residential, and office space, which produce a greater volume of sanitary discharge.

In 2022, Ciorba Group was awarded a contract to provide engineering services for the design of a replacement lift station due to the existing station's age and capacity limitations. Planned construction consists of demolition and abandonment of the existing lift station and construction of a new submersible-style lift station with wet well, valve vault, meter pit, and above grade electrical/controls.

DISCUSSION:

In June 2024, two bids were received for the replacement of Pfizer Lift Station, as summarized below:

Contractor	Bid Amount
Martam Construction, Inc.	\$2,724,781
Bolder Contractors, Inc.	\$2,756,633
Engineer's Estimate	\$3,212,616

Ciorba reviewed both submitted bids and has recommended awarding the contract to the low-bidder, Martam Construction Inc. Village Staff concurs with this recommendation. Ciorba's recommendation letter, bid tab, bid submittals, and contract are attached for review.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

There is \$1,860,000 in the 2024 Capital Improvements Program - Water and Sewer Fund for this project, which includes a \$1,200,000 contribution from Microsoft. As recommended by Ciorba, staff is requesting an additional 5% contingency in excess of the low bid for a total of \$2,861,000. Finance has indicated that there is sufficient balance that the additional \$1,001,000 can be sourced from Water and Sewer Fund reserves.

RECOMMENDATION:

Request authorization to award a construction contract to Martam Construction Inc. of Elgin, IL (low bid) for Pfizer Lift Station Improvements in an amount not to exceed \$2,861,000.

As requested, Ciorba Group has evaluated the bids submitted for the Pfizer Lift Station Improvements Project, received on June 12, 2024.

Two bids were received for the amount shown below. A bid tabulation was prepared and is included under Appendix A for your reference.

Contractor	Bid Amount
Martam Construction, Inc.	\$2,724,781.00
Bolder Contractors, Inc.	\$2,756,633.00
Engineer's Estimate	\$3,212,616.00

We have reviewed the submitted bid documents and offer the following evaluation:

#### **Bid Tabulation**

The submitted bids were approximately 15% less than the Engineer's Estimate. A review of Martam's unit costs revealed that the following Contract Pay Items were over 150% of the Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction Costs:

- Bituminous Materials (Tack Coat)
- Manholes
- Thermoplastic Pavement Marking Letters and Symbols
- Lift Station Electric Service
- Forcemain\*
  - \* Indicates those items which are greater than 2% of the total cost.

The increased cost for the tack coat, manholes, thermoplastic pavement markings, and electric service are justifiable given the small percentage of the total cost; however, the increased cost for the forcemain is significant. Ciorba can discuss with the Contractor should the Village like to pursue further to determine if the increased cost is a result of the poor soil conditions, high water table, or depth/location of the connection to the existing forcemain. It would appear that both Contractor's had similar concerns, since they both submitted similar unit cost for this pay item.

The difference between Martam and Bolder's bid amounts is \$31,852.00.

- Schedule of Prices
- Apprenticeship and Training Program Certification
- Affidavit of Illinois Business Office
- Bidder's Experience/Qualifications Sheet
- Exceptions and Deviations
- Major Equipment List
- Acknowledgement of Addendum No. 1

The Contractors were also present at the pre-bid meeting held at Public Works on June 3, 2024, and elected not to review the site.

#### **Bidders Experience/Qualifications**

Both Contractors have good reputations in the industry and have constructed numerous lift stations within Illinois. We do not have objections or concerns regarding the selection of either Contractor.

#### **Exceptions and Deviations Review**

Both Contractors did not submit any exceptions/deviations to the bid document or plans.

#### Major Equipment List Review

As requested, both Contractors submitted the Major Equipment List. Below is a side-by-side comparison of the Contractor's lists for reference:

<sup>\*</sup> In a follow-up phone call with Martam, they indicated that they anticipate using a slide rail system but would switch to sheet piling system if soil conditions were determined to be poor during dewatering procedures.

We do not have objections to the equipment/subcontractors submitted but do have some concerns regarding the Earth Retention System (ERS). The plans and specifications recommended a more robust, engineered, earth retention system be constructed for the project. Ciorba's design and construction team will review the slide rail system proposed to determine if the means and methods are an acceptable approach. However, the choice of means and methods, if approved by the Engineer, is the liability of the Contractor.

#### Construction Contingency

Per the Village's request, we have evaluated whether the Village should include a contingency amount for the construction of the project.

Base d on the existing soil conditions, high water table, utility conflicts, and construction proximity to the County and Tollway, we would recommend including a minimum 5% contingency to address potential increases in project costs associated with the following:

- Pavement Restoration
- Non-Special Waste Disposal
- Connection to Existing Forcemain
- Utility Conflicts

#### Recommendation

Based on the above evaluation, Ciorba recommends that the contract for the Pfizer Lift Station Improvement Project be awarded to Martam Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$2,724,781.00.

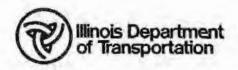

**PURPOSE:**

BACKGROUND:

The street preventative maintenance budget includes funding for crack sealing and surface patching. Both treatments have provided cost effective maintenance by increasing the service life of pavements for relatively low costs. The scope of the 2024 Preventative Maintenance Project solely includes crack sealing based on current needs.

Crack sealing is most effective when used on streets that have been reconstructed / resurfaced 4 to 9 years prior and are in good condition. Crack scaling helps keep water out of the roadway base and subbase which can help prevent future cracks from occurring.

DISCUSSION:

On July 2, 2024, one bid was received for the 2024 Preventative Maintenance Project. The engineer's estimate to complete all the work was \$216,000. A project map and list of locations are attached for reference. A bid summary is shown in the following table:

Table 1 – Bid Summary

Bidder	Bid Cost
Patriot Pavement Maintenance	\$201,251

Patriot Pavement Maintenance submitted the lowest qualified bid of \$201,251. Patriot Pavement Maintenance satisfactorily completed multiple crack sealing projects for the Village in the past and is qualified by IDOT to perform this type of work.

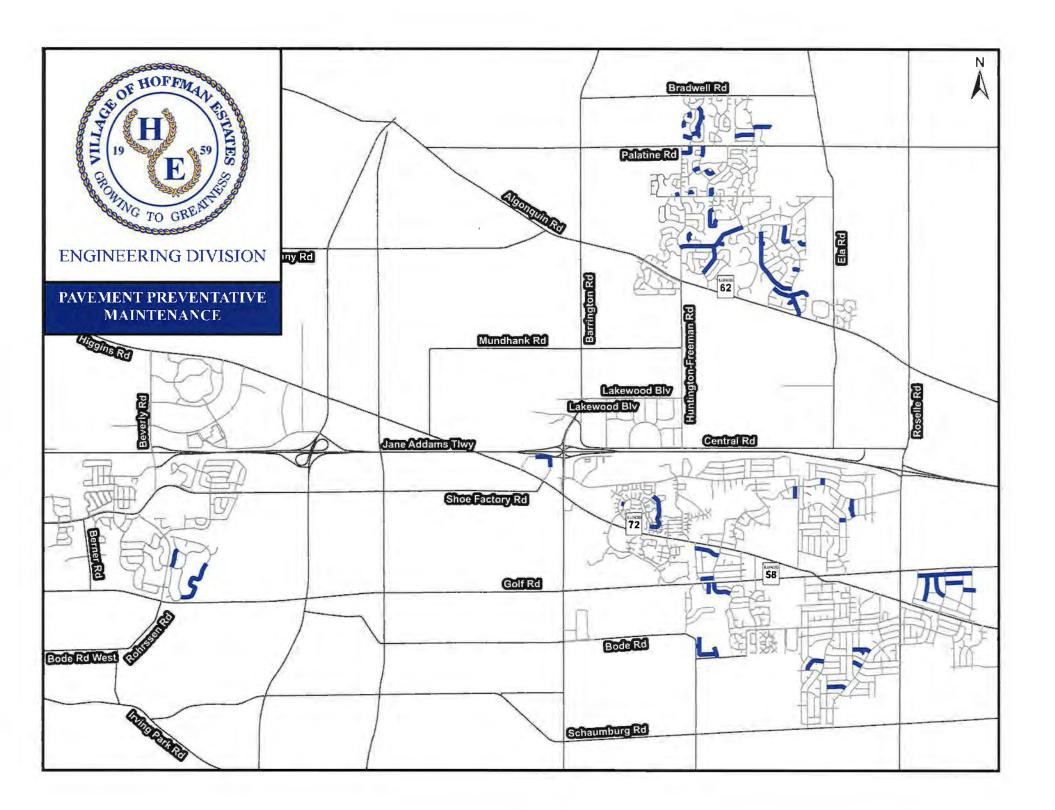
#### **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

#### **MAJOR PROJECT UPDATES:**

#### Well #10 Rehabilitation

Summary: Well #10 is the backup supply well for the South Pressure Zone which produces approximately 1,000

gallons per minute when fully operational. This well is being rehabilitated to ensure sufficient and redundant emergency backup water supply for the north and south zones, which are interconnected.

Status: Following an inspection of the well piping, motor, and related components, it was determined that the

existing motor could not reasonably be rehabilitated and must be replaced.

Latest Update: A new motor has been purchased and well pump reinstallation is anticipated in the coming months.

#### Water Tower Painting - T-5

Summary: LC United Painting Company was awarded the contract to paint the water tower located on Olmstead

Drive. Painting work is anticipated to begin after May 1, 2024 and be completed no later than July 19,

2024.

Status: Interior blasting and coating, exterior blasting and coating, and various repairs and safety/structural

upgrades are included within the scope of work. Structural rehab and interior removal and recoating is

complete.

Latest Update: Removal of the exterior coating is complete; painting/recoating of the exterior is ongoing. Once

complete, cellular antennas will be reinstalled on the tank prior to project closure.

#### **Engineering for Pfizer Lift Station Improvements**

Summary: Ciorba Group is providing engineering services in preparation for the replacement of Pfizer Lift

Station. The scope of work will include demolition and abandonment of the existing station,

construction of a new submersible-style station, above-grade electrical and controls, and installation of

a new upstream manhole.

Status: Bids were recetly received for construction and construction management for the replacement of Pfizer

Lift Station.

Latest Update: Award of the construction contract for this project is pending Village Board approval. Work is

expected to begin in August 2024.

#### **VILLAGE PROJECT UPDATES**

#### 2024 Preventative Maintenance

Bid opening held on July 2. Recommendation of contract award presented to Public Works & Utilities Committee on July 15.

#### 2024 Storm Sewer Rehabilitation

Design ongoing. Staff preparing bidding documents.

#### 2023 Street Revitalization

Completion of minor punch list items ongoing.

#### 2024 Street Revitalization - Contract 1 and 2

Contract 1: Work ongoing. See attached project update. Contract 2: Work ongoing. See attached project update.

#### 925 Grand Canyon Parkway Basin

Living Waters Consultants is contracted to complete conceptual design and evaluate alternatives to address shoreline erosion concerns at this location. Concept plan has been completed and reviewed by staff. Grant application for IEPA Section 319 funding submitted on May 1.

#### **Barrington Square Town Center Sanitary Sewer**

Alternative analysis review complete. Design is ongoing with expected completion of design in early 2024. V3 contracted for design engineering services.

#### Batavia Lane (Rebuild Illinois Funds)

Work substantially complete. Punch list completion is ongoing. Chastain & Associates contracted for construction engineering services.

#### Beverly Road Path & Resurfacing (Beacon Pointe Drive – Prairie Stone Parkway) (STP-L funding)

Work is ongoing. Stage 1 work complete and Stage 2 lane closures are in effect. Bridge deck work is ongoing. Civiltech contracted for construction engineering services.

#### **Bridge Inspections**

Agreement with Civiltech for 2024-2025 program management approved. Required 2024 inspections expected to begin in summer 2024.

#### Collector Street Lighting

Work on Thacker St and Illinois Blvd scheduled to resume the week of July 15. Contractor is awaiting delivery of light poles and foundations.

#### Floodplain Elevation Surveying Services

Elevation certificates currently under review. V3 contracted for surveying services.

#### Gannon Drive (Golf Road - Higgins Road)

FHWA Local Coordination Meeting was held on June 4. Received IDOT Traffic Section Review Comments. Environmental Survey Request (ESR) review by IDOT ongoing. Completion of Phase 1 and design approval expected in January 2025. Funding for construction/construction engineering has been included in the Northwest Council of Mayors Proposed FFY 2025-2029 STP-L Program that was approved on April 29. TranSystems contracted for Phase I engineering services.

#### Hassell Road STP Resurfacing (2025) (Fairway Court – Rosedale Lane)

Agreement for Phase II design engineering approved and executed in October 2023. Project kick-off meeting was held in December 2023. IDOT Phase II kick-off meeting was held on February 22. Staff completed review of prefinal plans. Environmental Survey Request (ESR) sent to IDOT for review and approval. Design ongoing. Civiltech contracted for design engineering.

#### Hoffman Boulevard Bridge Deck Resurfacing

Design engineering contract was awarded to Civiltech. Kick-off meeting was held in September 2023. Staff submitted funding request to IDOT.

#### Huntington Boulevard Water Main Replacement (South of Lakewood Boulevard – Mundhank Road)

Staff completed review of 90% plan submittal. IEPA permits submitted for review and approval. Awaiting submittal of final plans for review. Project scheduled to be bid in August 2024. HR Green contracted for design engineering.

#### Village Hall Parking Lot Improvements

MWRD Green Infrastructure Partnership kick-off meeting was held on May 30. Staff is reviewing draft IGA documents provided by MWRD. Construction will be required to be completed in 2025. Hey & Associates contracted for design engineering services.

#### Advocate Outpatient Center – 4847 Hoffman Boulevard

Mass grading work complete. Water, sanitary, and storm installation substantially complete. Building work and site paving work is ongoing.
