

VILLAGE OF HOFFMAN ESTATES Refuse and Recycling Program

The Village of Hoffman Estates is providing this informational brochure as part of your collection service. Please be aware of the following collection rules contained within this brochure:

Program Highlights

<u>Unlimited Standard Refuse Service</u> – Residents are permitted to either place refuse within plastic bags at the curbside or may elect to rent a 95-gallon cart. No resident owned containers are permitted.

<u>Collection Days</u> – Residents living North of I-90 are collected on Monday and South of I-90 (including households on the western end of the Village) receive collection service on Wednesday.

<u>Yard Waste Program</u> – Yard waste must be placed in designated biodegradable paper bags and each bag requires a pre-paid sticker. The sticker retailers are located within this brochure. Residents may also sign up for the yard waste subscription.

<u>Single-Sort Recycle Program</u> – Recycling may be mixed in a single stream and must be placed in your designated 65-gallon cart. Contact the Village at 847-843-4824, if you do not have a recycle cart.

Garbage Set Out Hours – Garbage/Recycling bins and toters cannot be set out before 6 pm the evening before collection day and must be stored behind the front property line on the side or rear of property or inside of a garage by 10 pm on collection day.

Online Bill Pay — Residents are able to pay bills online. Visit www.hoffmanestates.org and click "Online Payments" and select "Utility Billing" for garbage payments.

User Guide





Unlimited Standard Refuse Service:

Service includes collection of unlimited household garbage, including bulk items, on your regularly scheduled collection day for a flat fee. The unlimited flat fee program requires the continued use of bags only at the curb unless a refuse cart is ordered. The existing collections are collection services to the North of I-90 on Monday and the residents to the South of I-90 collected on Wednesday.

Senior Citizen Discount/Benefit Access

All seniors, 65 and older, or hardship/disability must register in person at the Village Hall in order to qualify for the discount. Once qualified, only seniors may then elect to order a 35-gallon cart. A copy of the property tax bill or a Benefit Access Card is required to prove eligibility. Please note, Benefit Access enrollment is now through the Township of Schaumburg. The telephone number is 847-884-0030 and the website is www.cbrx.il.gov.

Holiday Collection Schedule

The following holidays will affect the regularly scheduled collections in the Village of Hoffman Estates:

New Years Day
July 4th
Memorial Day
Labor Day
Thanksgiving Day
Christmas Day

If the holiday falls on a weekday, on or before your scheduled collection, service will be delayed by one day for the remainder of the holiday week. If the holiday falls on Sunday, it will be observed on Monday and service will be delayed one day the entire week.

Moving In or Out?

New residents must call the Village to begin service. Persons moving out of a home must call to discontinue service and to avoid billings to your name after your move. Please call 847-843-4824.

Yard Waste Program

Residents are able to purchase stickers to dispose of yard waste. The sticker is to be affixed to each 30-gallon biodegradable bag containing yard waste. Yard waste will be collected on the same day as refuse during the months of April 1st through November 30th each year. Rigid containers are not permitted. Sticker prices are online at www.hoffmanestates.org/garbage.

Yard Waste Subscription Program

Residents may elect to subscribe to our yard waste program that does not require the use of stickers. Services include unlimited curbside



collection of yard waste contained in biodegradable bags not exceeding forty-five (45) pounds. Rigid containers are not permitted. Collection will be on the same day as refuse during the months of April 1st through November 30th. To subscribe, contact Groot directly at 847-734-6400.

Yard waste too bulky to be placed in a bag, such as branches or brush, must be securely tied (with twine) and bundled. Bundles may not exceed four (4) feet in length, three (3) feet in diameter. Additionally bundles may not contain limbs greater than eight (8) inches in diameter or forty-five (45) pounds in weight. Each bundle must have one yard waste sticker affixed for collection.

Single-Sort Recycle Program

Recyclable materials are collected curbside on your primary day of service. The collection crew will no longer separate the commingled and paper materials curbside. Recyclables are separated at Groot's automated recycling plant in Elk Grove Village. Please combine the following recyclable materials in the recycling cart:

Glass, Metal

Aluminum cans, metal cans, steel cans, tin cans, empty aerosol cans, foil & foil trays. Glass bottles & jars (clear, green, brown).

Plastics

Pop bottles, milk jugs, as well as all containers labeled PET #1, HDPE #2, #3, #4, #5 and #7.

Paper Materials


Newspaper, office paper (computer/ledger) junk mail, chip board (cereal boxes, etc.) magazines, telephone books and mixed paper (white and colored).

Cardboard

Cardboard boxes must be broken down, flattened and cut into a manageable size (2' x 2'). Place these materials inside your cart.

Before you toss it in the green cart. .

... Please rinse all items to remove food residue.



Please place only approved items in the recycle cart. The collector is trained to check the contents of the bin. If there are foreign materials present, the cart will be left with a tag.

White Goods/Appliances

Residents are required to call 24 hours in advance to schedule a pick up. There is no charge for this service. Call Groot at 847-734-6400 for additional information.

General Billing Information

Billing for Village residents is invoiced monthly in advance of each service period. The monthly rates are available at www.hoffmanestates.org/garbage.

Service Termination Procedures

Please note, a minimum service level of one (1) time per week at the curb is required per Village ordinance.
