AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE AMENDMENT TO BUTERA PROPERTY, LLC (OWNER) AND KRIPA MONTESSORI SCHOOL (TENANT), 1007-1015 W. GOLF ROAD, HOFFMAN ESTATES, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission, at a public hearing duly called and held according to law on September 21, 2011, considered the request by Butera Property, LLC (owner) and Kripa Montessori School (tenant), of property legally described on Exhibit "A" and attached hereto and made a part hereof, for a special use amendment from the Zoning Code to allow the expansion of the daycare/preschool (to 6,770 square feet) on the property located at 1007-1015 W. Golf Road; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission made certain Finding of Fact attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "B" and recommended approval of a special use amendment to the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have received and considered said recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the proposed special use amendment has met the standards of Section 9-1-18-I of the Zoning Code of the Hoffman Estates Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hoffman Estates, Cook and Kane Counties, Illinois, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: The Corporate Authorities hereby find that the facts and statements contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are true.

Section 2: A special use amendment authorized under Section 9-8-2-C-5 of the Zoning Code is hereby granted to Butera Property, LLC (owner) and Kripa Montessori School (tenant) to allow for the expansion of the daycare/preschool (to 6,770 square feet) on the property located at 1007-1015 W. Golf Road, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a) all conditions from the original special use Ordinance No. 1934-1988 shall remain in effect; and
- b) prior to issuance of a final certificate of occupancy for the expansion area, a copy of the Illinois DCFS occupancy approval shall be provided to the Village; and
- c) no drop-off or pick-up of children in traffic aisles within the shopping center shall be permitted. Adults dropping off and picking up a child shall park legally and accompany the child to and from the daycare center/preschool. The tenant shall monitor and manage where their customers and employees park to ensure that no customers stop/stand along the curb in the fire lanes when dropping off/picking up.

<u>Section 3</u>: The Village Clerk is hereby authorized to publish this ordinance in pamphlet form.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage and approval.

The petitioner described their plans to expand their existing business, which was opened in 1988, into an adjacent vacant tenant space. The business has been growing and the expansion is necessary to avoid having to move to another location. The Commissioners asked about whether the parking demand of the expansion would be detrimental to the use of the parking lot by customers of other businesses. The sentiment of the Plan Commission was that the morning and evening parking of the parents for the additional approximately 30 children could be accommodated, and the business will monitor the parking to ensure that no illegal parking occurs. The parking is also staggered over a one to two hour period in the morning and evening so the overall parking impact is minimal. The business is not expected to have a negative effect on existing facilities or ingress/egress.

It was noted that parents are required to sign in/out their children.

The petitioner had no objections to the recommended conditions. The petitioner will provide a copy of the DCFS permit from the State as soon as it is available.

The Commission unanimously recommended approval of the proposed special use amendment.

Attached hereto is the Treasurer's Report for the month of September 2011, summarizing total cash receipts and disbursements for the various funds of the Village.

Cash disbursements and transfers-out exceeded cash receipts and transfers-in for the operating funds by \$1,862,441. After including these receipts and disbursements, the balance of cash and investments for the operating funds is \$21.0 million. For all of the Village funds, cash disbursements and transfers-out exceeded cash receipts and transfers-in by \$1,627,575, primarily due to general operating expenditures, offset by receipt of the Sears Naming Rights payment. Overall, the total for cash and investments for all funds decreased to \$149.4 million.

HISTORY

The Village Board approved a Site Plan Amendment and Plats of Vacation, Easement and Resubdivision of the Devonshire Woods Subdivision on September 12, 2011. As part of the Site Plan Approval, the petitioner is required to dedicate the land that is currently Lot 19 to the Hoffman Estates Park District to satisfy previous outstanding issues the original developer had with the park district. One of the Conditions of Approval for the site plan required that a Plat of Subdivision be submitted to and approved by the Village as part of the conveyance of this land. This plat is also a requirement addressed in the settlement agreement between the Villager and the Developer.

PLAT OF SUBDIVISION

The proposed plat shows the previously platted Lot 19 (per Document No. 0720615092) being consolidated into the previously platted Lot B (also per Document No. 0720615092) creating a new Lot B that would be approximately 9.74 acres. Lot B currently serves as detention for the subdivision as well as being a large portion of Black Bear Park. It will continue in this same fashion and no house will be permitted on this area after the consolidation. This plat will be recorded within the time frame denoted in the previously approved settlement agreement between the petitioner and the Village. All prior easements will remain in place.

STAFF SUMMARY

As part of the Conditions of Approval for the previously approved Site Plan, the petitioner was required to submit a plat of subdivision for the conveyance of the land previously platted as Lot 19 to the Park District. HISTORY

The Village Board approved the Final Site Plan for a governmental land use (police station) on September 8, 2008 after it was reviewed by the Planning, Building, & Zoning Committee on the same date. The conditions of approval required that the property be rezoned to one zoning district (B-2) instead of the current mixed zoning of R-3 and B-2 and that a Plat of Subdivision combining the individual parcels into one lot be done. This was delayed until now due to a gap that was discovered between two of the parcels owned by the Village and this piece of property needed to be acquired through legal process before the plat and rezoning could occur.

REZONING (MAP AMENDMENT)

The subject property is currently made up of three separate parcels and is zoned B-2 Community Business on the parcels that abut Higgins Road and R-3 One Family on the parcel that abuts the single family homes in Parcel C to the south. This rezoning will change the zoning of the entire property to B-2 Community Business District as required by the Conditions of Approval for the Site Plan approved in 2008 to provide single consistent zoning.

REZONING (MAP AMENDMENT) STANDARDS

Section 9-1-17 E. of the Zoning Code – *Findings of Fact and Recommendations* – states that where the purpose and effect of the proposed amendment is to change the zoning classification of a particular property, the Planning and Zoning Commission shall make findings based upon the evidence presented to it in each specific case with respect to the following:

- a. Existing uses of property within the general area of the property in question;
- b. The zoning classification of property within the general area of the property in question;
- c. The suitability of the property in question for the uses permitted under the existing zoning classification;
- d. The trend of development, if any, in the general area of the property in question, including changes, if any, which may have taken place since the day the property in question was placed in its present zoning classification.

The proposed rezoning of the site is consistent with the area as part of the property is already zoned B-2 and B-2 zoning is in place east of here as well as commercial zoning being in place across the street in Schaumburg. The police station meets the area regulations for the B-2 district and is considered a permitted use in the zoning district.

PLAT OF SUBDIVISION

As required by the Conditions of Approval for the Site Plan approved in 2008, a Plat of Subdivision is required to combine the existing parcels into one lot. The proposed plat would consolidate the existing parcels into one lot of record. The proposed Lot 1 is approximately 5.8 acres and has frontage along both Higgins Road and Spring Mill Drive. The lot has shared access and parking agreements with the Church of the Cross immediately to the west of it. These previously approved agreements between the Village and the church have already been recorded against both properties and are denoted on the plat. Additionally, a previously recorded ingress and egress easement would be vacated as part of the plat as it is no longer needed or usable since it is located under the new police station building.

STAFF SUMMARY

The proposed actions of rezoning and final plat complete the last of the Conditions of Approval imposed on the Site Plan approval for the project.


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
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FINAL PLAT OF SUBDIVISION

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8-3-22, NUMBER OF LICENSES OF ARTICLE 3, ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS, OF THE HOFFMAN ESTATES MUNICIPAL CODE (DECREASE IN NUMBER OF CLASS "A" AND CLASS "LC" – METROPOLIS RESTAURANT)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hoffman Estates, Cook and Kane Counties, Illinois, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: That Section 8-3-22, <u>NUMBER OF LICENSES</u>, of the Hoffman Estates Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

The number of licenses issued to persons for the sale of alcoholic liquors by the Village of Hoffman Estates shall be limited to forty-three (43) Class "A" licenses, two (2) Class "AA" licenses, fifteen (15) Class "B" licenses, unlimited Class "C" licenses, three (3) Class "D" licenses, two (2) Class "DD" license, one (1) Class "F" license, one (1) Class "G" license, unlimited Class "H" licenses, and twelve (12) Class "LC" licenses.

Section 2: That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 3: That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to publish this ordinance in pamphlet form.

<u>Section 4</u>: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage and approval.
