February 2013

Attached hereto is the Treasurer's Report for the month of February 2013, summarizing total cash receipts and disbursements for the various funds of the Village.

Cash disbursements and transfers-out exceeded cash receipts and transfers-in for the operating funds by \$1,314,260. After including these receipts and disbursements, the balance of cash and investments for the operating funds is \$20.0 million. For all of the Village funds, cash disbursements and transfers-out exceeded cash receipts and transfers-in by \$10,722,225, primarily due to the EDA note payment. The total for cash and investments for all funds decreased to \$151.4 million.
