Trustee Gaeta shared his opinion that he liked Option A without the brickwork.

Trustee Vandenbergh expressed her preference for the full seal instead of the watermark and also that she liked the brickwork on the base.

Trustee Stanton shared that he preferred Option C.

Trustee Mills shared that she would like to see the address on the bottom of the sign.

Trustee Pilafas requested that the Public Works department come back to Committee with additional options.

Mayor McLeod agreed with Trustee Pilafas.

Trustee Vandenbergh expressed concern about the address at the base of the sign being obscured by snow.

Mr. Nebel explained that he would look for additional designs and options within the \$8,000 budget.
